1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the report is to set out the terms of reference for the Audit Committee for approval.

2. BACKGROUND

In line with standing orders (and the health board's scheme of delegation), the board nominated a committee to be known as the Audit Committee. As such, terms of reference were developed to set out its role, responsibility and operating arrangements.

3. GOVERNANCE AND RISK ISSUES

The terms of reference are required to be reviewed annually in-line with the health board's governance framework and good governance principles. Failure to do so could result in the committee not discharging its duties appropriately putting the health board's governance arrangements at risk.
