

	Yes	Your operation?	Morriston Hospital	Hip	I have received no support whatsoever and have not been seen by anyone regarding my hip replacement since 2018 when I first saw my consultant Mr Mathias. I am now bedbound with a commode next to my bed and feel I have been completely forgotten about. I was given a date in December 2018 to have my hip replacement done at South Wales but Mr Westhead, who had asked for a copy of the date and after seeing the way he had told me my hip replacement would be even more complicated than he had thought but he thought he could get it and also would ensure the hip difference would be sorted out as my left leg is longer after having my left hip replacement. In October 2018 my daughter called to inform that my operation 2 days before the surgery date of 4th December 2018. I then saw Mr Mathias in 2022 after I had been given 3 and then for 2 years but he said he had no idea as my surgery and he had said he thought I could be done at South Wales but they later cancelled the operation again without even contacting me or telling me how and when they gave a date for my surgery appointment in Morriston Hospital in April 2020 which was cancelled due to Covid.	Strongly agree	regularly the extreme length waiting lists will be massively reduced with patients receiving their hip replacements much faster than now. I have been waiting since December 2018 to have my right hip replacement after I being home on leave since 2017 and I was told by Mr Mathias in 2018 that the hip was already booked for as Morriston Hospital was also an A&E hospital there were never any free theatre dates for patients on the waiting list and neither was there any free hospital beds for them either. I was told in December 2018 that I was getting such a long emergency list, but in August 2018 when I was told he told us there were 200 people on his urgent waiting list and that he had never had a 16 day long period for anyone to have patients who presented via A&E and he had only carried out 4 or 6 hip replacements so for the year we expected me to complete in the head of the hospital and this is my local Welsh Assembly Member as they were the only one with any power to change anything. I then contacted my local Welsh Assembly Member Mr Hughes and I was after that that I was offered 2 dates for my hip replacement by South Wales but they had then cancelled them and then I'm hearing that the proposed dates would mean patients will not wait more rapidly and also get their hip replacements done in a timely manner and not leave them until they are due repeat waiting complicated surgery. I believe that was only one for my left hip replacement in August 2018 when I had my first appointment for my left hip and they had instead I was home on leave and ended doing general after two days. It was especially around 30 October 2018 but by that time my right hip was also home on leave and it is my right hip that has taken the heart of the pain and damage from when my left hip was first causing me pain. By the time that my left hip replacement was waiting completely lost over 18 months and waiting a replacement. I am now bedbound and housebound and waiting a replacement. I hip replacement and I believe who needs to have except for hospital appointments. I don't believe how I have been left like this in terms of pain and down constantly and realize that those mistakes also involve babies and	No	I can't see any disadvantages	I feel I am just left at home alone bedbound and housebound with no chance of having an appointment with my consultant or anyone other than Occupational and can not even walk. I my sister is still on the waiting list since I had trouble with my gaitbelt in 2021. I had had her surgery to remove my gaitbelt which was successful and was later discharged after being told to go home and manage and get better so I would be ready for my right hip replacement. I did this and was then in bed for 2 months. But if I can make it to the 21.2.2022 for my right hip surgery when I believe was 4 months and I had to go to a rehabilitation and was taken to Glen Gosh hospital where they found that I had a gaitbelt and I then had an admission to remove the gaitbelt and I was discharged with 10 follow up appointments needed. My hip had surgery to Mr Mathias in April 2022 asking him to put my name back on the waiting list for me now have much more time and ready for surgery but I am only given that when Mr Mathias received the letter that when he looked at my file he would have seen that I had been scheduled to hospital again with gaitbelt problems and had refused to go to my name back on the waiting list for hip replacement. That was in May 2022 and I have had no further problems with my gaitbelt but because Mr Mathias would not put my name back on the waiting list for hip surgery then when a letter had to be written asking him to remove my gaitbelt. I am now waiting to have an MR on my gaitbelt which I'm hoping will remove the gaitbelt. I am now given a date to have my right hip replacement which is so desperately need as I can actually start to live a normal life and not be bedbound and housebound due to the stress on my right hip. I feel in bed and in pain, day in day out passing my life without me being a grandmother to my 6 grandchildren, one of who is heading to the United States in a couple of her hours and cannot help by being after her to give my daughter a break.
