- Fire Exception Report on Gorseinon Hospital A report was received which detailed findings outlining a number of recommendations to improve on the overall fire precautions for the building and processes in place.
- **Update on recent fires** A report detailed actions taken to date and actions to complete following recent fires across the health board.
- Medical Records at Morriston Hospital Members received an update which detailed a
 reported Health and Safety Executive (HSE) breach regarding social distancing concerns at
