#### CORPORATE GOVERNANCE REPORT

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

To report on corporate governance matters arising since the previous meeting.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

There are a number of corporate governance matters which have to be reported to the board as a regular item in-line with standing orders. This report encompasses all such issues as one agenda item.

#### 3. GOVERNANCE AND RISK ISSUES

i. Transfer of responsibility for the Stop Smoking Wales Service from Public Health Wales NHS Trust to Local Health Boards.

A letter received on the 30<sup>th</sup> September from Vaughan Gething AM, confirmed the decision to transfer responsibility for the delivery of the Stop Smoking Wales (SSW) service from Public Health Wales NHS Trust to Local Health Boards (LHBs), with effect from 1st October 2019. As a result of the transfer, LHBs will be responsible for the planning, organisation and delivery of all face-to-face smoking cessation services within their areas.

To retain the specialist expertise in the Stop Smoking Wales Service, those PHW employees currently providing face-to-face services will be transferred to the employment of the LHBs.

Public Health Wales NHS Trust will continue to provide the 'once-for-Wales' functions in the Help Me Quit system, including marketing, workforce training and development, and quality assurance and improvement, to support local delivery by LHBs.

The Welsh Ministers will continue to fund the transferred services, but will re-allocate the funding from PHW to each LHB, accordingly.

#### ii. Matters Considered In-Committee

In accordance with standing orders, the health board is required to report any decisions made in private session, to the next available public meeting of the board.

The following items during the in-committee board session in September 2019:

- Key Issues Report from In-Committee Board Committee meetings a report on key issues discussed at recent meetings was received for assurance.
- Sensitive Matters verbal reports on sensitive matters including Health and Safety Executive HSE recent visit, Operational Pressures and the Annual Plan 2019-20 were noted.
- Transcutaneous Aortic Value Insertion TAVI a report providing an update in relation to the external review of TAVI was received for noting.

- **Brexit** a report providing an update in relation to Brexit (Britain's exit from the European Union) was noted.
- Ratification of Chairman's Action reports were received seeking ratification of Chairman's action for endoscopy insourcing and for clinical negligence.

The following items during the special in-committee board meeting in October 2019:

- Major Trauma Network a briefing on the development of the programme business case for the major trauma network was noted
- **Financial Plan 2019-20** it was noted that further work was to be undertaken to develop the financial plan for 2019-20;
- Annual Plan 2019/20 a report was received seeking approval of the annual plan 2019/20 unscheduled care and planned care trajectories.

### iii. Affixing the Common Seal

In-line with standing orders, a routine report on documents to which the common seal has been affixed is required. Attached at **appendix 1** are details taken from the seal register. All documents have been signed by the Chairman or Vice-Chairman and an executive director or the Director of Corporate Governance, in line with the requirements.

## iv. Welsh Health Circulars (WHCs)
