# REVISED TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE PERFORMANCE AND FINANCE COMMITTEE

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the report is to set out the terms of reference for the Performance and Finance Committee for approval.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

In line with standing orders (and the health board's scheme of delegation), the board nominated a committee to be known as the Performance and Finance Committee. As such, terms of reference were developed to set out its role, responsibility and operating arrangements.

## 3. GOVERNANCE AND RISK ISSUES

The terms of reference are required to be reviewed annually in-line with the health board's governance framework and good governance principles. Failure to do so could result in the committee not discharging its duties appropriately putting the health board's governance arrangements at risk.

There are minor suggested changes to the terms of reference, which are tracked in appendix one. These are namely the removal of reference to workforce performance, which will be covered in the Workforce and Organisational Development (OD) Committee and changes to the membership to reflect updates to the executive team.
