Situation

The ability to recruit and place the required workforce to support the Urgent and Emergency Care programme is identified as a key risk to delivery. Recruitment to critical posts is monitored via a recruitment tracker, supported by the programme office team.

Background

Swansea Bay University Health Board is transforming its urgent and emergency care services, by re-designing acute medical services, and building capacity within the community, via multi-disciplinary virtual wards.

Assessment

This report summarises the current position of the recruitment of critical posts within the Urgent and Emergency Care programme's Step Up Step Down project.

Progress of recruitment is tracked via a recruitment tracker, with key posts reported fortnightly into the Step Up Step Down Core Steering Group.

It is essential that hiring managers provide timely information the programme office team, for the recruitment tracker to be kept up to date, to inform the project plan, and mitigation actions.
