EXTERNAL INSPECTIONS

1. SITUATION

This report provides the Committee with a summary in respect of activity relating to external inspections and letters from inspectorates from 1st February 2019 to 29th March 2019.

2. EXTERNAL INSPECTIONS

There has been two inspections across Abertawe Bro Morgannwg University Health Board in the specified time period

West Cross Lane Dental Surgery

Inspection date 22nd February 2019

An immediate improvement notice was issued, and the problems identified are summarised as follows:-

- HIW could not be assured on the day that the dentist was keeping comprehensive, succinct and contemporaneous records for the consultations and treatments of patients.
- HIW could not be assured on the day that processes were in place for the checking and disposal of out of date equipment and medicines.
- The practice had a dedicated area for decontamination procedures, however it was not compliant with regulations for ensuring a safe environment for sterilization of instruments.
- HIW could not be assured on the day that critical analysis of the radiological equipment had been undertaken in the last three years.

These findings were addressed and the improvement plan was submitted to HIW in March 2019.

HIW have yet to date not accepted the plan.

Neath South Community Mental Health Team – The Forge Centre

Inspection date 19th – 20th March 2019

An immediate improvement notice was issued, and the problems identified related to ligature points.

The Health Board provided all appropriate environmental and ligature risk assessments by the 29th March 2019.
