I refer to your Freedom of Information Act Request acknowledged by ourselves on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021. Your request sought information relating to staff vaccinations.

1. I am writing to request the job roles within the Health Board that have been vaccinated before the end of 2020.

The numbers of each job role (eg. Healthcare support worker, managerial, administration, Staff nurses, domestic staff) that have been vaccinated.

Please note with input from our ethics advisors, we agreed to prioritise front line/patient facing staff on their COVID-age as the first cohort to be vaccinated as these were the most vulnerable and therefore the staff to gain the most from early vaccination. This process was superseded once the supplies increased and a central booking facility had been established.

## 2. What percentage of the total of these jobs within the health board have been 'offered' and vaccinated before the start of the new year.

The vaccination has been offered to all front line workers in the health board in line with national JCVI guidance.
