Please provide a breakdown of where Covid 19 infections were contracted within the health board for the period 1st to 24th December 2020. You clarified on 6th January 2021 that you would like to know specifically where infections were contracted, as per example below

Infection caught whilst in hospital

There have been 121 "definite" hospital acquired COVID-19 infections within the given timeframe in Swansea Bay University Health Board's hospitals. "Definite" hospital-acquired infection is defined as a positive test result on day 15 or later after admission to one of our hospitals.

- Infection caught in restaurants or pubs
- Infection caught in hairdressers & beauty salons
- Infection caught in non-essential retail
- Infection caught in supermarkets
