You asked:

1. Total A+E Admissions on 25/12/23 for your region

We have provided both attendances and admissions for our Emergency Department & Minor Injuries Unit.

2. Total Accidental Injury Cases Reported in A&E on 25/12/23 for your region.

You clarified on 28th October 2024 that you would like us to include any unintentional injury excluding self-harm and assault. Include bites and stings. Does not have to include word "accidental".

- 41 attendances for defined unintentional injury
- 18 attendances for injuries not defined – further detail is not included on the attendance record, so it is not possible to discern whether these were "accidental" or not.
- All other assault and self-harm injuries and attendances excluded.

3. The Reported Mechanism of Injury for reported Accidental Injuries on 25/12/23 for your region. The mechanism of injury recorded for 'accidental' injuries (I understand that some elements or reporting such as 'accidental' or

an acknowledgement of the mechanism of injury is not a mandatory field when recording in A&E. However what data you do have will be greatly received).

Of the 59 total injury attendances (including injuries not defined) -

Where fewer than 5 (<5) has been indicated we are unable to provide you with the exact number of patients as due to the low numbers, there is a potential risk of identifying individuals if this was disclosed. We are therefore withholding this detail under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This information is protected by the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 and its disclosure would be contrary to the data protection principles and constitute as unfair and unlawful processing in regard to Articles 5, 6, and 9 of GDPR. This exemption is absolute and therefore there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.
